Whites


29 | Hornhead | Chardonnay | South of France | Bottle £24.50 | 175ml £6.00 | 250ml £8.60

A bright pale gold in the glass, the nose is soft and full of ripe fruit aromas like melon and pear. The palate is fruity and soft with a good roundness. 


20 | Neptune Point | Sauvignon Blanc | New Zealand, Marlborough | Bottle £26.00 | 175ml £6.40 | 250ml £9.10

This Sauvignon Blanc is a lovely fruity and aromatic wine with notes of citrus fruits, gooseberry and a subtle vanilla touch.

22 | Bodegas Taron Blanco | Tempranillo Blanco & Viura | Spain, Rioja | Bottle £28.00 | 175ml £6.90 | 250ml £9.80


A crisp and fresh white made from the local Viura variety. The bouquet has notes of citrus, green apple and white blossom. These fresh fruit notes continue on the palate with some white peach and the zesty acidity that the region of Rioja Alta is famous for. 

24 | La Tunella | Pinot Grigio | Italy, Friuli | Bottle £31.50 | 175ml £7.75 | 250ml £11.00


A fresh Pinot Grigio with rare depth and elegance from youthful, modern winery in Italy's classic Friuli region. Fresh and expressive, with acacia blossom, tropical fruit and subtle brioche notes. 

Rosés


44 | Quinta Vista Rosé | Cabernet Sauvignon & Castelao | Portugal, Lisboa | Bottle £24.50 | 175ml £6.00 | 250ml £8.60

Vibrant fruity notes of raspberries and strawberries and spicy notes. A very fresh and balanced wine, with a long and pleasant aftertaste. 

45 | Vignobles Foncalieu | Picpoul de Pinet | South of France | Bottle £27.50 | 175ml £6.75 | 250ml £9.65


Salmon pink in colour, this rosé has a lovely nose of summer fruits and blossom. The palate is crisp and clean with a good citric acidity and flavours of strawberry, raspberry and red cherry with subtle floral hints of rose and blossom. A perfect summer wine, easy drinking and very fresh. 

46 | Biscardo Rosapasso Rose | Pinot Noir | Italy, Veneto | Bottle £28.00 | 175ml £6.90 | 250ml £9.80

A brilliant rosé colour, the bouquet of elegant wild strawberry and cherry lead onto the smooth and harmonic palate. Excellent with fish, cheese and lightly flavoured risotto's and pasta. 

Reds


50 | Indomita 'Nostros' Reserva | Pinot Noir | Chile, Maipo Valley | Bottle £24.50 | 175ml £6.00 | 250ml £8.60

A light, fragrant red made from grapes grown in the cooler Casablanca region of Chile. Bright, wild strawberry and raspberry fruits dominate a soft, supple palate, which leads through to a gentle, warming finish. 


59 | Adegas Galegas Salterio | Mencía | Spain, Bierzo | Bottle £26.50 | 175ml £6.50 | 250ml £9.30

Fragrant on the nose with delicate aromas of red cherries, blackberries and a hint of violet. The persistent mineral note present on the nose is echoed on the palate. Dense with a rounded texture, Salterio displays concentrated flavours of sweet and savoury cherry, complimented by light floral notes. Its spicy touch and lingering freshness make it a very versatile wine.

60 | Yalumba Y Series | Shiraz & Viognier | South Australia | Bottle £27.50 | 175ml £6.75 | 250ml £9.65

Luscious and exotic aromas of boysenberry, Turkish delight, vanilla bean and violets. The medium-bodied palate is framed by flavours of sweet Turkish delight and violets, while soft tannins provide a perfect complement to the succulent finish, which shows the synergy between these two varieties. 




71 | Zuccardi Valles | Malbec | Argentina, Mendoza | Bottle £31.50 | 175ml £7.75 | 250ml £11.00

This Malbec is a delicious expression of the Uco Valley, with vibrant plum and raspberry flavours complemented with fresh and spicy notes on the finish.

It has a nose of ripe berry fruit and a supple palate finishing with black cherries, violets and blackberry fruit.

Sparkling Wines


1 | Le Contesse Prosecco 20cl | Glera | Italy, Veneto | £9.00

Sparkling wine obtained from an exclusive selection of grapes from the Treviso plains area. It is light straw yellow colour with fine bubbles. Fruitful and typical nose. Soft and lightly aromatic taste.


2 | Le Contesse Pinot Rose 20cl | Pinot Blanc & Pinot Noir | Italy, Veneto | £9.00

Fresh, creamy with generous red currant notes from the Pinot Noir, and citrus fruit flavours from the Chardonnay with a round, soft finish. Enjoy on its own or with tapas.

3 | Biscardo Prosecco Spumante 'Millesimato' | Glera | Italy, Veneto | £26.50

Intense and aromatic, with hints of apple and peach blossom. A smooth and velvety finish. Excellent as aperitif, perfect with appetizers but also an ideal accompaniment to the entire meal, particularly with fish courses. 


4 | Biscardo Prosecco Spumante 'Millesimato' Rosé | Glera & Pinot Nero | Italy, Veneto | £26.50

Salmon pink with a fine and persistent perlage. Intense and aromatic on the nose with hints of red currant, wild strawberry and rose petal. This is elegant, smooth and velvety on the palate with a harmonious dry finish. 



5 | Laborie Blanc de Blanc | Chardonnay | South Africa, Western Cape | £35.00

This complex and indulgent MCC shows clarity of fruit on the nose. Aromas of toasted bread and hazelnut accompany hints of lime. The palate is creamy, round and textured with an explosive acidity and lasting, elegant finish.

6 | Jansz Premium NV Cuvee | Chardonnay, Pinot Meunier & Pinot Noir | Tasmania | £44.50

Old World inspiration combined with New World innovation. Honeysuckle and citrus scents are immediately apparent with slight aromas of nougat, roasted nuts and a sniff of strawberry from the Pinot Noir. Delicate fruits and creaminess wash through the mouth with a lingering finish of citrus and nougat. 

7 | Davenport Limney Estate, Vintage | Chardonnay & Pinot Noir | England | £69.50

Green apple and conference pear fruit, buttery richness from the lees ageing and mineral earthiness from the Pinot Noir and citrus drive and edge from the Chardonnay.  

Champagne

8 | Ayala Brut Majeur NV | Chardonnay, Pinot Meunier & Pinot Noir | France | £55.00

Light gold colour, with abundant, fine bubbles. Open and expressive on the nose with delicate, unveiling notes of citrus, flowers and white fruits. Balanced on the palate, precise, fruity and characterised by a long finish.

9 | Ayala Brut Majeur NV | Half Bottle | £30.00

10 | Ayala Rosé Majeur NV | Chardonnay, Pinot Meunier & Pinot Noir | France | £58.00

Ayala Rosé shows a lovely pale colour, with a delicate pink hue. On the nose, it is charming, generous and open, revealing aromas of strawberries, raspberries and vine peaches. It is light yet expressive with great freshness, due to the high proportion of Chardonnay. Notes of red gooseberries and raspberries, with a lengthy and voluptuous finish.

11 | Nicolas Feuillatte Selection Brut Yellow Label NV | Chardonnay, Pinot Meunier & Pinot Noir | France | £62.50

Different Cru wines from the Champagne region are harmoniously blended to reveal magnificent fruity structure, and unparalleled elegance. On the nose intense floral and white fruit aromas, developing into honeysuckle, pear and citrus. Delicate on the palate, with a creamy texture and an appealing freshness.

12 | Binon Coquard Brut Classic NV | Chardonnay, Pinot Meunier & Pinot Noir | France | £65.00

This Champagne is the perfect introduction to the Binon-Coquard range. The appearance is pale yellow with a persistent line of bubbles. On the nose, you get firstly a hint of mineralogy that appears as chalk, flintstone, then it becomes fine and elegant with light notes of citrus and rhubarb. The taste is fresh and light at first, and then it reveals itself as fruity and smooth. You find the aromas of white fruits such as pear, green apple and vine peach. Beautiful length in the mouth.

14 | Bollinger Brut Special Cuvee NV | Chardonnay, Pinot Meunier & Pinot Noir | France | £75.00

This is a traditional Champagne, with a yeasty nose, crisp acidity and a rich, full-bodied palate. To the eye: a golden colour, distinctive of black grape varieties, very fine bubbles. To the nose: a beautiful aromatic complexity; ripe fruit and spicy aromas; hints of roasted apples, apple compote and peaches. On the palate: a subtle combination of structure, length and vivacity; bubbles like velvet; pear, brioche and spicy aromas, notes of fresh walnut.

15 | Bollinger Brut Rosé NV | Chardonnay, Pinot Meunier & Pinot Noir | France | £80.00

This highly polished rosé combines notes of plum, patisserie, cinnamon and spice. With structure and weight and harmony of vibrant flavours right across the palate, this is a delicious accompaniment that can match a variety of dishes.

16 | Ruinart Blanc de Blancs Brut N.V | Chardonnay | France | £99.00


Luminous pale gold colour, with fine, light bubbles that rise in a delicate, long-lasting line. On the nose there is fresh fruit (mostly citrus) combined with aromas of white flowers & white fruits (peach). This is a very attractive Blanc de Blancs, pure distinct & clear-cut. Evolves in the mouth, fluctuating between freshness, suppleness & fullness.

17 | Dom Perignon Vintage 2008 | Chardonnay & Pinot Noir | France | £220.00


Super fresh and intense aromas of lemons, grapefruit and blood-orange peel. Incredible freshness here. The palate has a very smoothly delivered, berry-pastry thread with light, sweet spices, stone fruit and fine citrus fruit. The 2008 vintage is widely hailed as a brilliant vintage.

Crisp, Light & Fresh Whites

18 | White & Sea | Colombard & Sauvignon Blanc | South of France | £23.00

Dry, fresh white packed with citrus and some tropical aromas. Lemon, green apple and a hint of passion fruit on the palate. Balanced by refreshing acidity and a lovely zesty finish. 


19 | Calcada Lago | Arinto, Azal, Loureiro & Trajadura | Portugal, Vinho Verde | £24.50

Pineapple, mango and floral notes with a soft minerality. Bright and clear with a light citric colour, some evident tropical aromas reminding of pineapple, mango and citrines. Fruity blended with interesting floral notes. It presents itself with a soft minerality, very well balanced and medium structure. 


20 | Neptune Point | Sauvignon Blanc | New Zealand, Marlborough | £26.00

This Sauvignon Blanc is a lovely fruity and aromatic wine with notes of citrus fruits, gooseberry and a subtle vanilla touch.

21 | Ornezon, Vignerons De Florensac | Picpoul De Pinet | France, Languedoc-Roussillon | £26.50

Classic Picpoul, full of citrus and stone fruit flavours. Pale yellow with green hues, this lovely and fresh Picpoul has plentiful aromas of grapefruit and citrus fruit as well as bracing citrus and stone fruit flavours. 


22 | Bodegas Taron Blanco | Tempranillo Blanco & Viura | Spain, Rioja Alta | £28.00

A crisp and fresh white made from the local Viura variety. The bouquet has notes of citrus, green apple and white blossom. These fresh fruit notes continue on the palate with some white peach and the zesty acidity. 

23 | Hauts Pemion, Muscadet Sevre et Maine Sur Lie, Cuvee Selection | Muscadet | France, Loire | £29.00

Christophe Drouard makes classic Muscadet. Clean, fruity, well balanced and finish with a lovely softness.

24 | La Tunella | Pinot Grigio | Italy, Friuli | £31.50

A fresh Pinot Grigio with rare depth and elegance from youthful, modern winery in Italy's classic Friuli region. Fresh and expressive, with acacia blossom, tropical fruit and subtle brioche notes. 

25 | Lagar De Cervera | Albarino | Spain, Rias Baixas | £34.00

An impressive example of Spain's iconic white varieties, from the sea-swept Rías Baixas region. The juicy fruit is lifted by delicious freshness, with notes of stone fruit and minerality. A treat for lovers of elegantly aromatic whites

26 | Ascheri, Gavi di Gavi | Cortese | Italy, Piedmont | £37.50


This wine has a delicate pale straw colour with highlights of green. The fragrant fresh nose displays notes of a floral, green fruit character with a minerally undertone. The palate mirrors the nose with its fresh and delicate approach, dry and balanced this wine has a good length.

27 | Domaine Fourrey, Chablis 1er Cru, Mont de Milieu | Chardonnay | France, Burgundy | £39.00


The Chablis has a fresh and lively nose with a beautiful structure. An attack is frank and good persistence.

Aromatic and Fruitier Whites


28 | Mont Rocher, Vieilles Vignes | Viognier | South of France | £22.50

A haunting honeysuckle and apricot aroma and rich, almost unctuous palate that is somehow still dry, tangy and refreshing. 

29 | Hornhead | Chardonnay | South of France | £24.50

A bright pale gold in the glass, the nose is soft and full of ripe fruit aromas like melon and pear. The palate is fruity and soft with a good roundness. 

30 | Vignerons Ardechois, Côtes du Rhône Blanc | Grenache Blanc, Marsanne & Viognier | France, Ardeche | £26.50

Made from grapes cultivated at low yields. A white wine with floral and fruity notes and a full and balanced palate. Pairs really well with fish dishes. 


31 | Pasqua, Passione Sentimento, Veneto Bianco | Garganega | Italy, Veneto | £26.50

This is an alluring white wine. Intense aromas of citrus fruits, almond and peaches on the nose, followed by a palate, which is refreshing and well balanced with a lingering, finish.


32 | Casas Del Bosque, Blanc Reserva | Sauvignon Blanc | Chile, Casablanca Valley | £26.50

On the nose this wine shows intense notes of key lime, grapefruit and fresh ginger dominate with just a hint of salinity. In the mouth, bright flavours of ginger and citrus zest give way to a tight mineral backbone and good acidity. Delicious served chilled as an aperitif, or paired with light pasta dishes, salads or poultry.


33 | Huber, Terrassen | Grüner Veltliner | Austria, Traisental | £29.50

Pure pepper on the nose; hinting at typical Grüner spiciness; aromatic herbs and yellow fruit; dense and complex on the palate. 

34 | Catherine Marshall, Jono's Wave, Amatra | Chenin Blanc | South Africa, Stellenbosch | £31.50

Bright, fresh, sweet melon and white peach top notes with fleshy ripe nectarines on the core and crisp green apple acidity on the finish. A rich mid-palate of lanolin adds depth and complexity to the wet granite stone texture. Primary white peach and fresh apple fruit aromatics may evolve into nutty, spicy baked apple and cardamom notes with age. 

35 | Pualetts, Polish Hills River | Riesling | South Australia | £33.00

The Clare Valley yields one of the world's great styles of Riesling. This youthful, aromatic, dry wine has intense mineral and floral aromas on the nose. These aromas follow through on the palate leading to flavours of lime, citrus and white blossom. Tropical fruits and citrus dominate the fresh, racy acidity and a distinct minerality comes through on the palate leaving a fantastic, clean finish. 


36 | Domaine Chauveau, Pouilly-Fume, La Charmette | Sauvignon Blanc | France, Loire Valley | £35.00

Clear colour with gold highlights. Citrus fruits and exotic fruits (mango) mainly compose the aromatic profile of this wine. The attack on the palate has a great vivacity, along with chalky mineral notes. Delicate and fresh in the palate with an excellent acidity and structure balance. It contributes to the persistence and pleasantly concludes the tasting.

37 | Hubert Brochard, Les Collines Blanches, Sancerre Blanc | Sauvignon Blanc | France, Loire | £36.50

Produced from 100% Sauvignon Blanc grapes. Domaine Hubert Brochard Sancerre Les Collines Blanches has fresh and fragrant Sauvignon Blanc fruit with overtones of gooseberries and a bright, refreshing acidity. First class Sancerre.

38 | Carl Koch, Sacktraeger, Trocken | Riesling | Germany, Rheinhessen | £39.50

Super clear, fresh and aromatic bouquet of great purity. Flint flavours intertwine with ripe stone fruit aromas, but the nose is coolish, fresh and very attractive with its ripe yellow stone fruit. Round, elegant and powerful on the palate, this is a full-bodied, very intense and juicy Riesling with lots of juice and power. 

Fuller Bodied Whites


39 | Cave de Lugny, Macon Lugny, 'Les Charmes' | Chardonnay | France, Burgundy | £32.50

The most famous and still probably the best Macon Lugny. Produced exclusively from the Chardonnay grape, the 'Les Charmes' vineyard produces a top quality white Burgundy. Full-flavoured, fruity and dry.


40 | Bodegas Protos | Verdejo | Spain, Rueda | £34.50

Greenish straw colour, bright and clean. Powerful nose, fruity with green apple, citrus and tropical fruits, white blossoms, fragrant herbs and fennel hints. Very fresh taste with good acidity; flavourful, fruity, well balanced and complex, with a long finish and slightly bitter aftertaste.


41 | Cave De Hunawihr, Reserve | Pinot Gris | France, Alsace | £35.50

Light, bright yellow in colour, this wine is full, spicy on the nose, with perfumes of apricots, and smoke. On the palate, it is relatively full-bodied with good balance of nutty, oily fruit and clean acidity despite the level of residual sugar. The clean dry finish prevents the wine from cloying. 

42 | Wildsong Organic | Pinot Gris | New Zealand, Hawkes Bay | £38.50


Pear, lychee and quince, muddled with loquat, almond and nectarine. An attractive textured palate with a balanced, dry finish that suits drinking chilled on its own or served alongside pretty much anything. 

43 | Bogle Vineyards | Chardonnay | USA, California | £38.50


Green apple and pear aromas classically characterise this wine as Clarksburg, while honeycomb and vanilla heighten the first impression. The rich, round entry rolls into a viscous and silky mouthfeel, surrounded by Asian pears and honey crisp apples. The finish lingers long and soft, like the wafting aromas of grandma's warm apple pie. 

Refreshing Rosés


44 | Quinta Vista Rosé | Cabernet Sauvignon & Castelao | Portugal, Lisboa | £24.50

Vibrant fruity notes of raspberries and strawberries and spicy notes. A very fresh and balanced wine, with a long and pleasant aftertaste. 

45 | Vignobles Foncalieu, Piquepoul Nose Rosé | Picpoul de Pinet | South of France | £27.50

Salmon pink in colour, this rosé has a lovely nose of summer fruits and blossom. The palate is crisp and clean with a good citric acidity and flavours of strawberry, raspberry and red cherry with subtle floral hints of rose and blossom. 

46 | Biscardo Rosapasso Rosé | Pinot Noir | Italy, Veneto | £28.00

A brilliant rose colour, the bouquet of elegant wild strawberry and cherry lead onto the smooth and harmonic palate. Excellent with fish, cheese and lightly flavoured risottos and pasta. 

47 | Hubert Brochard, Sancerre Rosé, Les Collines Blanches | Pinot Noir | France, Loire | £37.00


Pure Pinot Noir that has been aged for a short time in cask to add complexity to the palate. Light and bursting with red berry fruit with nuances of spice and liquorice.

48 | Chateau D'Esclans, Whispering Angel | Cinsault, Grenache & Vermentino | France, Cotes De Provence | £42.00


Brilliant orange-hued pink colour of this lively wine comes from a careful touch of skin contact as the free-run and press juices blended together. Grapes are mainly Grenache, Cinsault and a bit of the white grape Vermentino for added pizzazz. Pale pink in colour, it has flavours of redcurrant, dried flowers and spices on the nose, with a subtle herbal quality. Dry, with bitter red fruit flavours, it has a firm finish with lingering herbal notes.

Softer and Lighter Reds

50 | Indomita 'Nostros' Reserva | Pinot Noir | Chile, Maipo Valley | £24.50

A light, fragrant red made from grapes grown in the cooler Casablanca region of Chile. Bright, wild strawberry and raspberry fruits dominate a soft, supple palate, which leads through to a gentle, warming finish. 

51 | Finca Manzanos | Tempranillo | Spain, Rioja | £25.00

This is a great modern style of Rioja with enticing nose of ripe black and red fruits leading to a smooth, rich satisfying palate with a hint of spice. Round and well balanced. Easy drinking but enough body to accompany red meat dishes. 

52 | Cave De Fleurie | Gamay | France, Beaujolais | £28.50

A lovely intense garnet red robe. The nose opens on to small red fruit and blackcurrant. Good attack on the palate with a supple feel and fruit and freshness at the end.


53 | Vina Zorzal, Joven | Garnacha | Spain, Navarra | £29.00

On the nose, clove, black fruit, followed by soft cherry and ripe fruit aromas. The palate is very soft, full-bodied and powerful, with a long, balanced and nice aftertaste. Ideal for cured ham, stew and meat dishes.

54 | Allegrini, Valpolicella | Corvina & Rondinella | Italy, Veneto | £30.50

This Valpolicella from the hills of the Classico area is a delicious example of the wine this area is famous for. Corvina expresses its vibrant and quaffable character with fresh and bright cherry flavours.

55 | Yealands, 'Single Vineyard' Black Label | Pinot Noir | New Zealand, Awatere | £32.50


On the nose, this wine exhibits notes of sweet dark cherry, violets and smoky-spice. The palate is full and plush, yet lively with flavours of cedar and red liquorice balanced with silky tannins. 

56 | Domaine Cornu Camus, Hautes-Côtes Du Beaune | Pinot Noir | France, Burgundy | £34.50


The Hautes Côtes de Beaune is a product of old vines and a low yield with no new oak in the ageing process. The wine is a joy to drink, a bowl full of berries on the nose, mineral-laced fruit in the mid palate with the structure and length that is the hallmark of Cornu Camus wines.

Medium-Bodied Reds

57 | Evaristo Tinto | Alicante, Cabernet Sauvignon, Syrah & Touriga Nacional | Portugal, Lisboa | £24.00

A deliciously fruity blend of indigenous Portuguese and international grape varieties grown in the vineyards surrounding Lisbon. This easy-drinking wine is bursting with aromas of ripe cherries, juicy blackberries and blackcurrants. 


58 | Flying Solo, Domaine Gayda | Grenache & Syrah | France, Pays d'Oc | £24.50

An explosion of red fruits on the nose, followed by soft tannins and a smooth, fruity palate. The finish is fresh with a good length. 


59 | Adegas Galegas Salterio | Mencia | Spain, Bierzo | £26.50

Fragrant on the nose with delicate aromas of red cherries, blackberries and a hint of violet. The persistent mineral note present on the nose is echoed on the palate. 61 | Michel Lynch, Organic Red | Merlot | France, Bordeaux | £28.50

Beautiful intense and deep red colour with aromas of blackcurrant, black cherry and hints of violet. Supple and round, this wine displays an attractive concentration with silky smooth tannins and a nice flavourful finish. 

62 | Da Vinci, Chianti Reserva | Sangiovese, Merlot & Local Grapes | Italy, Tuscany | £29.50

The wine is made from 85% Sangiovese grapes with 10% Merlot grapes and 5% other varietals included for additional complexity. A charming Chianti full of fruit and spice, juicy and approachable, with cherries offset by an exotic perfume of vanilla and cinnamon.

63 | 'Protea', Anthonij Rupert Wyne | Merlot | South Africa, Franschhoek | £30.50

Bright blue and black berry fruit aromas with a light leafy brush and cocoa nuances. In the mouth, the wine is immediately fruity, supple, soft and rounded with abundant juiciness. The rich, dark berries come through, along with the gentle spice and cocoa notes. The texture is plush and velvety which makes this a very appealing wine. Good pliable structure and length of flavour.


64 | Natte Valleij | Cinsault | South Africa, Stellenbosch | £32.50

A deep perfumed lift on the nose. Silky tannins, cherries, strawberries, ripe fruits, a hint of spice and a sun-soaked savouriness. Long bright finish.

65 | Argiano, Rosso Di Montalcino | Sangiovese | Italy, Tuscany | £36.50



Deep ruby red in colour. It is medium bodied with a good concentration on the mid-palate. Elegant in the mouth, it is well balanced with tempting flavours of red berries, violets, menthol and earthiness. A generous wine with smooth, velvety tannins that will satisfy all Sangiovese lovers.

66 | Spencer, Lemberg | Pinotage | South Africa, Tulbagh Valley | £38.00

A mineral core that offers structure and interest underlines dark berry and cherry notes on both the nose and palate. 

Rich and Fuller Bodied Reds

67 | Terre De Mistral, Côtes du Rhône | Carignan, Grenache, Mourvèdre & Syrah | France, Southern Rhône | £26.50

Ripe red/dark fruit aromas and that characteristic garrigue and pepper notes. Lovely softness in the mouth with velvety tannins and confit fruits building across the palate, hints of tobacco and leather and a nice spine of acidity from the Syrah as well as some spicy blackcurrant fruit.  


68 | Casas Del Bosque, Reserva | Carmenere | Chile, Rapel Valley | £27.50

Intensely violet in colour, on the nose this wine exhibits notes of cedar, bacon fat, and graphite with just a hint of fresh lavender. In the mouth, an initial attack of black cherry, sweet tobacco and cinnamon gives way to a touch of earthiness and bell pepper. Ripe tannins and fresh acidity give good balance and length.


69 | Baglio Gibellina, Passimiento | Nero d'Avola | Italy, Sicily | £28.50

Mediterranean fragrance. Bright intense red, characteristic, intense with hint of red berries fruits. Warm, full-bodied and harmonious in acidity, with smooth and elegant tannins.

70 | Paolo Leo Passitivo Organic | Primitivo | Italy, Puglia | £30.50

Intense ruby-red colour, with a complex bouquet, reminiscent of cherries, raspberries and redcurrants. The oak aging adds a pleasant roasted and spicy aroma. On the palate, it is full-bodied, supple and well balanced with a long finish. 



71 | Zuccardi Valles | Malbec | Argentina, Mendoza | £31.50

This Malbec is a delicious expression of the Uco Valley, with vibrant plum and raspberry flavours complemented with fresh and spicy notes on the finish. 

72 | Bogle Vineyards | Merlot | USA, California | £36.50

Concentrated and full-bodied, subtle and silky, yet bright and intense, this deep red wine is multifaceted. Black raspberry and dark cherry greet the nose, while the brighter fruit of ripe summer plum dazzles the palate. The toast and spice of twelve months in American oak seamlessly integrate with the tannin structure of this wine, leaving a long, lingering finish.

73 | The Ladybird | Cabernet Franc, Cabernet Sauvignon, Malbec, Merlot & Petit Verdot | South Africa, Stellenbosch | £38.50

This wine is a Bordeaux influenced blend, and has a complex nose with hints of spice, chocolate and mocha. Good structure with plum and mineral complexity and a lingering finish. Showing graceful elegance, this wine over delivers on quality and displays this estate as one of the leading lights in South Africa.  

74 | Chateau Villa Bel Air | Cabernet Franc, Cabernet Sauvignon & Merlot | France, Bordeaux | £42.50



The colour and tannins of the wine are delicately extracted by employing traditional vinification methods and long maceration. The resulting wine combines power and refinement. It exhibits a deep purple-crimson robe, a nose of violets and ripe red fruits with hints of vanilla oak.

The Fine Wine Collection

White

80 | Cortese Venedda Bianco | Catarratto & Grillo | Italy, Sicily | £42.50

Golden in colour, which comes from the skin contact and ageing in large oak barrels. The prominent bouquet has notes of coconut and tropical fruit, with an undercurrent of gentle spices. On the palate, there is a richness, balanced by well-integrated acidity.

Excellent structure and length.  

81 | Little Beauty, 'Black Edition' | Sauvignon Blanc | New Zealand, Marlborough | £45.00

Exotic, intriguing, integrated, opulent and thought provoking. Wild flowers, wild herbs, grilled apricot, frozen mango, dried dates, nutty, crème brûlée, passion-fruit pulp, brioche, baking bread, sandalwood...it goes on and on!

82 | Eric Forest, Pouilly-Fuisse | Chardonnay | France, Burgundy | £52.50

An avalanche of complex flavours reveal themselves with every sip, including lime crème, spiced pear, tangerine, vanilla and toast. The structure is beautiful, with interwoven acidity quietly balancing the density and length.

83 | Ken Forrester, The FMC | Chenin Blanc | South Africa, Stellenbosch | £60.00

This flagship wine is rich, seductive, and very sophisticated. Layer upon layer of candied lemon, dried apricot and vanilla, with a touch of honey and spice, effortlessly supported by gentle oak, and a lovely freshness. This wine is still showing the exuberance and nerviness of youth, and will develop and blossom even more over the next few years.

84 | Domaine Lamy Pillot, Chassagne-Montrachet, 1er Cru Morgeot | Chardonnay | France, Burgundy | £80.00

The Morgeot are wines whose approach may seem a little hard. The first five years often offer a slightly closed wine. Nevertheless, its guard is to its advantage, highlighting its power! Full bodied Chassagne, very elegant, acids still kicking through, peach, gooseberries, oak not yet molten.

Red



85 | Coto De Imaz, Gran Reserva | Tempranillo | Spain, Rioja | £42.50

The Gran Reserva has a brilliant ruby-red colour with tinges of brick red. Mature and elegant, the wine's rich aromatic complexity is initially subtle, revealing itself more and more as the wine breathes. Toasted oak nuances and coconut give way to notes of leather and damp earth from bottle ageing. On the palate, silky, rounded tannins accompany fresh red berries, dried raisins and spicy notes. This is a complex wine with exceptional concentration and a long finish.

86 | The Troublemaker | Grenache, Mourvèdre, Petit Sirah, Syrah & Zinfandel | USA, California | £45.00

Fruit-forward red wine with rich aromatics that display hints of smoke and violets, bright fruit on the palate and a long finish, Troublemaker shows amazing depth and structure.

87 | Domaine St Damien, Gigondas | Grenache & Mourvèdre | France, Rhône | £45.50

The flavours are of ripe, concentrated plum and cinnamon spice; the wine has a fantastic, rich mid-palate, which expands onto an exceptional finish.  

88 | Petit Corbin Despagne, 2nd Wine | Merlot & Cabernet Franc | France, Bordeaux | £47.50

Attractive fresh fruit and smooth tannins in the wine. 85% Merlot, 15% Cabernet Franc. Organic

89 | Pauillac de Lynch Bages | Cabernet Sauvignon & Merlot | France, Bordeaux | £53.00

An attractive, dark ruby colour. It releases fresh fruit aromas of red berries and what a joy to taste! Spicy and oaky notes mark the palate while the tannins are soft and round, but there is such energy on the palate. Very well poised, it finishes long.

90 | Fontanafredda, Barolo | Nebbiolo | Italy, Piedmont | £57.50

Robust, well-bodied wine packed with structure and is well capable of withstanding the test of time. It has an attractive ruby-red colour with garnet highlights, which become orange with the passing of time. Its bouquet is clean, full and intense, with the wine's typical traces of withered flowers, dry leaves and underbrush.

91 | Segla 2nd Wine of Ch. Rauzan-Segla, Margaux | Cabernet Sauvignon & Merlot | France, Bordeaux | £60.00

Elegant, refined texture, the depth, the length and breadth of flavour. The nose is ripe and fragrant, with notes of blackcurrant, damson, violet and toasted oak. The tannins are soft and silky, with a persistent finish.

92 | Senechoux, Chateauneuf De Pape | Grenache, Syrah & Mourvèdre | France, Bordeaux | £65.00

Full of warm spice and unfolds an inviting scent of red and black berries. A stately body supports the lush palate with the finely nuanced aromas of cherry marmalade, liquorice and Provencal herbs as well as spicy roasted notes.

100 | Domaine Chauveau, Pouilly-Fume, La Charmette | Sauvignon Blanc | France, Loire Valley | £21.50

Clear colour with gold highlights. Citrus fruits and exotic fruits (mango) mainly compose the aromatic profile of this wine. The attack on the palate has a great vivacity, along with chalky mineral notes. Delicate and fresh in the palate with an excellent acidity and structure balance. It contributes to the persistence and pleasantly concludes the tasting.

101 | Terras Gauda, De San Campio | Albarino | Spain, Rias Baixas | £22.50

The nose is filled with white fruit, grapefruit and citrus flavours. No sign of oak and no malolactic fermentation, the wine is therefore as pure and bright as a whistle with mandarin, exotic fruit, pineapple, minerals and sea scents joining in on the palate.

102 | Domaine Colombier, Chablis | Chardonnay | France, Burgundy | £24.00

A lively wine with plenty of acidity and grip, this great Chablis boasts gunflint aromas with minerals dominating the palate.

Rosé

103 | Chateau D'Esclans, Whispering Angel | Cinsault & Grenache | France, Cotes De Provence £24.50

The palate is all ripe strawberry, citrus and lemongrass. Well balanced with bright acidity and rich enough to pair up with salmon or even duck.

Red

104 | Cave De Fleurie | Gamay | France, Beaujolais £18.50

A lovely intense garnet red robe. The nose opens on to small red fruit and blackcurrant. Good attack on the palate with a supple feel and fruit and freshness at the end.

105 | Chateau d'Arcins, Haut-Medoc | Cabernet Franc, Cabernet Sauvignon & Merlot | France, Bordeaux | £22.50

The wine has remarkable body and aromas, with a finesse reminiscent of certain Margaux. A great wine with power, it has richness but also an elegance with fine and tasty tannins. It is pure pleasure with black fruit and an armful of old rose that supports some notes of exotic wood.

106 | Segla 2nd Wine of Ch. Rauzan-Segla, Margaux | Cab Sauvignon & Merlot | France, Bordeaux | £28.50

Elegant, refined texture, the depth, the length and breadth of flavour. The nose is ripe and fragrant, with notes of blackcurrant, damson, violet and toasted oak. The tannins are soft and silky, with a persistent finish.

110 | Le Trianon de Filhot | Sauternes | France, Bordeaux | Bottle 37.5cl £25.50 | 125ml £8.75

Trianon has a brilliant gold robe with golden reflections. The nose reveals notes of dried apricots, lemon and honey. On the palate, the Trianon has a nice balance on freshness supported by a supple structure.


111 | Domaine De Durban, Beaumes De Venise | Muscat | France, Rhône | Bottle 37.5cl £28.50 | 125ml £9.75

Apricot and white peach, with citric hints and a whiff of mandarins all combine in this wonderfully refreshing and finely balanced pudding wine.

112 | Chambers, Rosewood Vineyard | Muscat | Rutherglen Victoria, Australia | Bottle 37.5cl £30.50 | 125ml £10.35

The Rutherglen Muscat is typically tawny red in colour with aromas of rose petals, raisins and dried fruit. These characters carry through to the palate, balanced with fresh acidity. The wine is unctuous and rich yet zesty and balanced.  

113 | Royal Tokaji, Blue Label, 5 Puttonyos | Furmint, Hárslevelű & Muscat | Hungary, Tokaj | Bottle 50cl £40.50 | 125ml £11.00

A wine with lovely sweetness, balanced by a pronounced fresh acidity.

115 | Dalva Rosé | Portugal | Bottle 75cl £36.50 | 50ml £3.75

A very fruity Port. A wine with strong flavours of raspberry, strawberry, notes of cherry, honey and grapefruit. A good balance of sweetness.

116 | Sandeman, Tawny, 10 Year Old | Portugal | Bottle 75cl £45.00 | 50ml £4.75

Pale in colour and light in body, the nose opens with aromas of vanilla and raisins. On the palate, there is a great balance between fresh fruit flavours and more complex, spicy flavours from oak ageing. The finish is fresh and long-lasting.

The De-alcoholised white made of 100% Sauvignon Blanc is a light yellow with green tint in colour, flavours of ripe tropical fruit, yellow peaches and gooseberries complimented by a fresh acidity and lingering finish. 

Rosé Wine

132 | Darling Cellars Rosé, De-alcoholised Wine, 0.5ABV | Grenache & Sauvignon Blanc | South Africa | £20.50

A blend of Sauvignon Blanc and Grenache, this Rosé has a great light salmon pink colour, with ripe strawberries and sweet candyfloss on the nose following through to a balanced palate with a lingering finish.
