26 | Hornhead | Chardonnay | South of France | Bottle £26.50 | 175ml £6.85 | 250ml £9.40

A bright pale gold in the glass, the nose is soft and full of ripe fruit aromas like melon and pear. The palate is fruity and soft with a good roundness. 

19 | Turning Heads | Sauvignon Blanc | New Zealand, Marlborough | Bottle £28.00 | 175ml £7.20 | 250ml £9.90


Pale straw in colour, the wine has a bouquet of ripe gooseberries supported by herbal aromas and tropical fruit. The palate is richly textured, vibrant and tightly knit reflecting the quality of estate-grown grapes.

31 | La Tunella | Pinot Grigio | Italy, Friuli | Bottle £36.50 | 175ml £9.40 | 250ml £12.90


A fresh Pinot Grigio with rare depth and elegance from youthful, modern winery in Italy's classic Friuli region. Fresh and expressive, with acacia blossom, tropical fruit and subtle brioche notes. 

Rosés

45 | Vignobles Foncalieu | Picpoul de Pinet | South of France | Bottle £29.50 | 175ml £7.60 | 250ml £10.45


Salmon pink in colour, this rosé has a lovely nose of summer fruits and blossom. The palate is crisp and clean with a good citric acidity and flavours of strawberry, raspberry and red cherry with subtle floral hints of rose and blossom. A perfect summer wine, easy drinking and very fresh. 

46 | Biscardo Rosapasso Rose | Pinot Noir | Italy, Veneto | Bottle £ 30.50 | 175ml £7.85 | 250ml £10.80


A brilliant rosé colour, the bouquet of elegant wild strawberry and cherry lead onto the smooth and harmonic palate. Excellent with fish, cheese and lightly flavoured risotto's and pasta. 

Reds


49 | Indomita 'Nostros' Reserva | Pinot Noir | Chile, Maipo Valley | Bottle £26.50 | 175ml £6.85 | 250ml £9.40

A light, fragrant red made from grapes grown in the cooler Casablanca region of Chile. Bright, wild strawberry and raspberry fruits dominate a soft, supple palate, which leads through to a gentle, warming finish. 

58 | Yalumba Y Series | Shiraz & Viognier | South Australia | Bottle £31.50 | 175ml £8.10 | 250ml £11.15

Luscious and exotic aromas of boysenberry, Turkish delight, vanilla bean and violets. The medium-bodied palate is framed by flavours of sweet Turkish delight and violets, while soft tannins provide a perfect complement to the succulent finish, which shows the synergy between these two varieties. 

66 | Zuccardi Valles | Malbec | Argentina, Mendoza | Bottle £32.50 | 175ml £8.35 | 250ml £11.50

This Malbec is a delicious expression of the Uco Valley, with vibrant plum and raspberry flavours complemented with fresh and spicy notes on the finish.

A beautifully delicate, pale pink rosé. Soft and fruity with hints of rose petal and wild strawberry followed by a dry, well balanced palate of supple summer fruits.

Red

3 | Centenary Red | Merlot | France, Languedoc-Roussillon |

4 | Le Contesse Prosecco 20cl | Glera | Italy, Veneto | £10.00

Sparkling wine obtained from an exclusive selection of grapes from the Treviso plains area. A light straw yellow colour with fine bubbles. Fruitful and typical nose. Soft and lightly aromatic taste.


5 | Le Contesse Pinot Rose 20cl | Pinot Blanc & Pinot Noir | Italy, Veneto | £10.00

Fresh, creamy with generous red currant notes from the Pinot Noir, and citrus fruit flavours from the Chardonnay with a round, soft finish. Enjoy on its own or with tapas.

6 | Biscardo Prosecco Spumante 'Millesimato' | Glera | Italy, Veneto | £29.50

Intense and aromatic, with hints of apple and peach blossom. A smooth and velvety finish. Excellent as aperitif, perfect with appetizers but also an ideal accompaniment to the entire meal, particularly with fish courses. 

7 | Biscardo Prosecco Spumante 'Millesimato' Rosé | Glera & Pinot Nero | Italy, Veneto | £32.50

Salmon pink with a fine and persistent perlage. Intense and aromatic on the nose with hints of red currant, wild strawberry and rose petal. This is elegant, smooth and velvety on the palate with a harmonious dry finish. 

8 | Laborie Blanc de Blanc | Chardonnay | South Africa, Western Cape | £38.00

This complex and indulgent MCC shows clarity of fruit on the nose. Aromas of toasted bread and hazelnut accompany hints of lime. The palate is creamy, round and textured with an explosive acidity and lasting, elegant finish.

9 | Pierre Mauzac Brut Nature | Chenin Blanc & Mauzac | France, Limoux | £50.00

A bready, brioche, yeasty nose, and delicious lemony, appley, brioche flavours on the palate, This delicious sparkling possesses excellent energy and you could absolutely think you were drinking Champagne. A great mouth feel with a delicious long finish.

Champagne

10 | Gallimard Brut Cuvee Reserve NV | Pinot Noir | France, Champagne | £55.00

An attractive fruity nose, with aromas of exotic fruit. In the mouth, it is supple and very well balanced. The mousse is fine and long lasting. On any occasion, this Blancs de Noir will bring extra joy to all your moments of great happiness.

11 | Gallimard Brut Cuvee Reserve NV | Half Bottle | £32.50

12 | Gallimard Brut Rose NV | Pinot Noir | France, Champagne | £62.50

The colour is an intense and lively pink with exuberant exotic fruit and summer berry aromas and flavours. Ample and round on the palate with further notes of vanilla, strawberry and hazelnuts that linger in the full and fruity finish.

13 | Vazart Coquart Extra Brut NV Blanc de Blancs | Chardonnay | France, Champagne | £75.00

Clear lemon yellow in colour with light flashes of green, and a luxuriant, vivacious effervescence. More subtle notes of acacia blossom, mint and liquorice complement a touch of gourmandise on the nose with its aromas of pastry, preserved lemon, hazelnuts and almonds. The palate is fresh, textured and refined with hints of citrus and a mineral framework characteristic of the Grand Cru terroirs of the Côte des Blancs. The finish is saline, tangy and lightly lemony.

14 | Bollinger Brut Special Cuvee NV | Chardonnay, Pinot Meunier & Pinot Noir | France, Champagne | £89.50

This is a traditional Champagne, with a yeasty nose, crisp acidity and a rich, full-bodied palate. To the eye: a golden colour, distinctive of black grape varieties, very fine bubbles. To the nose: a beautiful aromatic complexity; ripe fruit and spicy aromas; hints of roasted apples, apple compote and peaches. On the palate: a subtle combination of structure, length and vivacity; bubbles like velvet; pear, brioche and spicy aromas, notes of fresh walnut.

15 | Bollinger Brut Rosé NV | Chardonnay, Pinot Meunier & Pinot Noir | France, Champagne | £95.00

This highly polished rosé combines notes of plum, patisserie, cinnamon and spice. With structure, weight, and harmony of vibrant flavours right across the palate, this delicious accompaniment can match a variety of dishes.

16 | Vazart Coquart Special Club 2013 Vintage, Blanc de Blancs | Chardonnay | France, Champagne | £120.00

The nose is aromatic, quite elegant and offers a slight creaminess. It reveals accents of lemon cream, fresh mandarin and nectarine associated with hints of fresh exotic fruits. The palate is well-balanced and matched by the nose with the addition of notes of fresh peach associated with the discreet hint of quine, honey as well as an imperceptible hint of brioche.


Andrew's favourite

17 | Dom Perignon Vintage 2008 | Chardonnay & Pinot Noir | France, Champagne | £265.00

Super fresh and intense aromas of lemons, grapefruit and blood-orange peel. Incredible freshness here. The palate has a very smoothly delivered, berry-pastry thread with light, sweet spices, stone fruit and fine citrus fruit. The 2008 vintage is widely hailed as a brilliant vintage.

Crisp, Light & Fresh Whites

18 | Calcada Lago | Arinto, Azal, Loureiro & Trajadura | Portugal, Vinho Verde | £26.50


Pineapple, mango and floral notes with a soft minerality. Bright and clear with a light citric colour, some evident tropical aromas reminding of pineapple, mango and citrines. Fruity blended with interesting floral notes. It presents itself with a soft minerality, very well balanced and medium structure. 

19 | Turning Heads | Sauvignon Blanc | New Zealand, Marlborough | £28.00

Pale straw in colour, the wine has a bouquet of ripe gooseberries supported by herbal aromas and tropical fruit. The palate is richly textured, vibrant and tightly knit reflecting the quality of estate-grown grapes.

20 | Ornezon, Vignerons De Florensac | Picpoul De Pinet | France, Languedoc-Roussillon | £28.50

Pale yellow with green hues, full of citrus and stone fruit flavours. This lovely, fresh white is a classic Picpoul by all accounts. 

21 | Hauts Pemion, Muscadet Sevre et Maine Sur Lie, Cuvee Selection | Muscadet | France, Loire | £29.00

Christophe Drouard makes classic Muscadet. Clean, fruity, well balanced with a lovely softness to finish.

22 | La Tunella | Sauvignon Blanc | Italy, Friuli | £36.00

A distinctive style of Sauvignon Blanc with characteristic Friulian weight and finesse. Floral and fresh with ripe melon notes and a long, delicate minerality.

23 | Lagar De Cervera | Albarino | Spain, Rias Baixas | £40.25

An impressive example of Spain's iconic white varieties, from the sea-swept Rías Baixas region. The juicy fruit is lifted by delicious freshness, with notes of stone fruit and minerality. A treat for lovers of elegantly aromatic whites.

Tiago's favourite

24 | Ascheri, Gavi di Gavi | Cortese | Italy, Piedmont | £45.50


This wine has a delicate pale straw colour with highlights of green. The fragrant fresh nose displays notes of a floral, green fruit character with a minerally undertone. The palate mirrors the nose with its fresh and delicate approach, dry and balanced this wine has a good length.

25 | Domaine Du Colombier, Chablis 1er Cru, Vaucoupin | Chardonnay | France, Burgundy | £66.50


A fine and delicate Chablis with aromas of white flowers such as acacia and hawthorn, along with ripe white peach. The palate is full and beautifully weighted exhibiting more fruit and well balanced minerality.

Aromatic and Fruitier Whites

26 | Hornhead | Chardonnay | South of France | £26.50

A bright pale gold in the glass, the nose is soft and full of ripe fruit aromas like melon and pear. The palate is fruity and soft with a good roundness. 


27 | Vignerons Ardechois, Côtes du Rhône Blanc | Grenache Blanc, Marsanne & Viognier | France, Ardeche | £28.50

Made from grapes cultivated at low yields. A white wine with floral and fruity notes and a full and balanced palate. Pairs really well with fish dishes. 

28 | Pasqua, Passione Sentimento, Veneto Bianco | Garganega | Italy, Veneto | £30.50


This is an alluring white wine. Intense aromas of citrus fruits, almond and peaches on the nose, followed by a palate, which is refreshing and well balanced with a lingering, finish.

29 | Catherine Marshall, Jono's Wave, Amatra | Chenin Blanc | South Africa, Stellenbosch | £34.00


Bright, fresh, sweet melon and white peach top notes with fleshy ripe nectarines on the core and crisp green apple acidity on the finish. A rich mid-palate of lanolin adds depth and complexity to the wet granite stone texture. Primary white peach and fresh apple fruit aromatics may evolve into nutty, spicy baked apple and cardamom notes with age.

30 | Huber, Terrassen | Grüner Veltliner | Austria, Traisental | £35.00

Pure pepper on the nose; hinting at typical Grüner spiciness; aromatic herbs and yellow fruit; dense and complex on the palate. 

31 | La Tunella | Pinot Grigio | Italy, Friuli | £36.50

A fresh Pinot Grigio with rare depth and elegance from youthful, modern winery in Italy's classic Friuli region. Fresh and expressive, with acacia blossom, tropical fruit and subtle brioche notes. 

Telma's favourite

32 | Philip Shaw, The Dreamer | Viognier | Australia, Orange, New South Wales | £39.50

The Dreamer is light straw yellow in colour with hues of green. Fresh apricots and violets on the nose with lifts of lemon. The palate is bright and fresh with vivid acid and juicy fruit. The balance of fruit and acid give the wine depth and vibrancy.

33 | Hubert Brochard, Les Collines Blanches, Sancerre Blanc | Sauvignon Blanc | France, Loire | £47.50

Produced from 100% Sauvignon Blanc grapes. Domaine Hubert Brochard Sancerre Les Collines Blanches has fresh and fragrant Sauvignon Blanc fruit with overtones of gooseberries and a bright, refreshing acidity. First class Sancerre.

34 | Antinori, Le Mortelle Vivia | Vermentino & Viognier | Italy, Tuscany | £48.50

On the nose offers aromas of ripe fruit, especially pears and apples, in perfect harmony with subtle floral notes of lavender and chamomile. Its bouquet is completed by elegant sensations of citrus fruit and aromatic herbs. On the palate, it is pleasantly savoury and crisp with a persistent finish defined by hints of lemon and rosemary.

Alfredo's favourite

35 | Tyrrell's Hunter Valley | Semillon | Australia, New South Wales | £49.00

Bright, attractive green in colour, the nose shows intense citrus characters. The palate is expansive and powerful, hallmarks of a warmer vintage. Wonderful length and flavour with the pedigree of the vineyards showing through. A wine that defies the challenging vintage.

36 | Trimbach | Gewurztraminer | France, Alsace | £56.00

Finely balanced and very aromatic with notes of lychee, rose and ginger. This is dry and with classic restraint, while at the same time expressing beautifully the varieties is exotic and spicy character.

Jake's favourite

Fuller Bodied Whites

37 | Cave de Lugny, Macon Lugny, 'Les Charmes' | Chardonnay | France, Burgundy | £34.00

The most famous and still probably the best Macon Lugny. Produced exclusively from the Chardonnay grape, the 'Les Charmes' vineyard produces a top quality white Burgundy. Full-flavoured, fruity and dry.

38 | Bodegas Protos | Verdejo | Spain, Rueda | £36.00

Greenish straw colour, bright and clean. Powerful nose, fruity with green apple, citrus and tropical fruits, white blossoms, fragrant herbs and fennel hints. Very fresh taste with good acidity; flavourful, fruity, well balanced and complex, with a long finish and slightly bitter aftertaste.

39 | Eglantier, Vignerons Ardechois | Viognier | France, Ardeche | £37.50

A great Viognier in a traditional fleshy style. The nose is rich in fruits balanced with a subtle wild rose lift. Notes of apricot, peach & your finest pastry. Fuller in style with a fresh finish.

40 | Ken Forrester Reserve | Chenin Blanc | South Africa, Stellenbosch | £38.50

The nose is of melon and spicy baked apple. On the palate it is layered, with mineral notes, honeycomb and caramel flavours from lees contact. The fruit and delicate oak & vanilla zests combine to form complex, soft flavours with sufficient body to enhance even spicy meals.

Alfredo's favourite

41 | Bogle Vineyards | Chardonnay | USA, California | £39.50

Green apple and pear aromas classically characterise this wine as Clarksburg, while honeycomb and vanilla heighten the first impression. The rich, round entry rolls into a viscous and silky mouthfeel, surrounded by Asian pears and honey crisp apples. The finish lingers long and soft, like the wafting aromas of grandma's warm apple pie. 🍏

42 | Wildsong Organic | Pinot Gris | New Zealand, Hawkes Bay | £42.00

Pear, lychee and quince, muddled with loquat, almond and nectarine. An attractive textured palate with a balanced, dry finish that suits drinking chilled on its own or served alongside pretty much anything. 🍏

43 | Blank Bottle, Moment Of Silence | Chardonnay, Chenin Blanc & Viognier | South Africa, Wellington | £47.00

Absolutely banging salinity. Aromas of guava, pineapple, honeyed peach, and a hint of fynbos which melds with the faintest notes of classy old wood. It has a lovely generous texture. The Viognier comes through nicely, which we love. Balancing the full bodied feel in this vintage there is a lively clarity and freshness. 🍏

Refreshing Rosés

44 | Quinta Vista Rosé | Cabernet Sauvignon & Castelao | Portugal, Lisboa | £27.50

Vibrant fruity notes of raspberries and strawberries and spice. A very fresh and balanced wine, with a long and pleasant aftertaste.



45 | Vignobles Foncalieu, Piquepoul Nose Rosé | Picpoul de Pinet | South of France | £29.50

Salmon pink in colour, this rosé has a lovely nose of summer fruits and blossom. The palate is crisp and clean with a good citric acidity and flavours of strawberry, raspberry and red cherry with subtle floral hints of rose and blossom.



46 | Biscardo Rosapasso Rosé | Pinot Noir | Italy, Veneto | £30.50

A brilliant rose colour, the bouquet of elegant wild strawberry and cherry lead onto the smooth and harmonic palate. Excellent with fish, cheese and lightly flavoured risottos and pasta.



47 | Hubert Brochard, Sancerre Rosé, Les Collines Blanches | Pinot Noir | France, Loire | £42.00

Pure Pinot Noir that has been aged for a short time in cask to add complexity to the palate. Light and bursting with red berry fruit with nuances of spice and liquorice.

48 | Chateau Minuty Prestige | Grenache, Syrah & Cinsault | France, Côtes de Provence | Bottle £45.00

This light rosé wine expresses some very intense aromas of citrus fruit and white flowers. On the palate, a velvety texture combined with a fresh flavour gives this wine a certain ethereal quality.


49 | Antinori Tormaresca, Calafuria Rose | Negroamaro | Italy, Puglia | £48.50

A delicate rosé, pleasantly fresh, savoury and well developed that expresses all the aromas and colours of its native Salento. The Apulian rosé of Tormaresca, the only Italian rosé among the best in the world according to the Wine Spectator.

Softer and Lighter Reds

50 | Indomita 'Nostros' Reserva | Pinot Noir | Chile, Maipo Valley | £26.50

A light, fragrant red made from grapes grown in the cooler Casablanca region of Chile. Bright, wild strawberry and raspberry fruits dominate a soft, supple palate, which leads through to a gentle, warming finish. 

51 | Finca Manzanos | Tempranillo | Spain, Rioja | £27.00

This is a great modern style of Rioja with enticing nose of ripe black and red fruits leading to a smooth, rich satisfying palate with a hint of spice. Round and well balanced. Easy drinking but enough body to accompany red meat dishes. 

52 | Cave De Fleurie | Gamay | France, Beaujolais | £32.50



A lovely intense garnet red robe. The nose opens on to small red fruit and blackcurrant. Good attack on the palate with a supple feel and fruit and freshness at the end.

Telma's favourite


53 | Allegrini, Valpolicella | Corvina & Rondinella | Italy, Veneto | £35.00

This Valpolicella from the hills of the Classico area is a delicious example of the wine this area is famous for Corvina expresses its vibrant and quaffable character with fresh and bright cherry flavours.

54 | Vina Zorzal, Joven | Garnacha | Spain, Navarra | £36.50

On the nose, clove, black fruit, followed by soft cherry and ripe fruit aromas. The palate is very soft, full-bodied and powerful, with a long, balanced and nice aftertaste. Ideal for cured ham, stew and meat dishes.  

55 | Yealands, 'Single Vineyard' Black Label | Pinot Noir | New Zealand, Awatere | £45.00

On the nose, this wine exhibits notes of sweet dark cherry, violets and smoky-spice. The palate is full and plush, yet lively with flavours of cedar and red liquorice balanced with silky tannins. 


56 | Domaine Cornu Camus, Hautes-Côtes Du Beaune | Pinot Noir | France, Burgundy | £49.50

The Hautes Côtes de Beaune is a product of old vines and a low yield with no new oak in the ageing process. The wine is a joy to drink, a bowl full of berries on the nose, mineral-laced fruit in the mid palate with the structure and length that is the hallmark of Cornu Camus wines.

Medium-Bodied Reds

57 | Evaristo Tinto | Alicante, Cabernet Sauvignon, Syrah & Touriga Nacional | Portugal, Lisboa | £26.50


A deliciously fruity blend of indigenous Portuguese and international grape varieties grown in the vineyards surrounding Lisbon.

This easy-drinking wine is bursting with aromas of ripe cherries, juicy blackberries and blackcurrants. 

58 | Adegas Galegas Salterio | Mencía | Spain, Bierzo | £27.50

Fragrant on the nose with delicate aromas of red cherries, blackberries and a hint of violet. The persistent mineral note present on the nose is echoed on the palate. Dense with a rounded texture, Salterio displays concentrated flavours of sweet and savoury cherry, complimented by light floral notes. Its spicy touch and lingering freshness make it a very versatile wine.

59 | Yalumba Y Series | Shiraz & Viognier | South Australia | £31.50

Luscious and exotic aromas of boysenberry, Turkish delight, vanilla bean and violets. Soft tannins provide a perfect complement to the succulent finish. 

60 | Da Vinci, Chianti Reserva | Sangiovese, Merlot & Local Grapes | Italy, Tuscany | £33.50

The wine is made from 85% Sangiovese grapes with 10% Merlot grapes and 5% other varietals included for additional complexity. A charming Chianti full of fruit and spice, juicy and approachable, with cherries offset by an exotic perfume of vanilla and cinnamon.

Feby's favourite

61 | 'Protea', Anthonij Rupert Wyne | Merlot | South Africa, Franschhoek | £35.50


Bright blue and black berry fruit aromas with a light leafy brush and cocoa nuances. In the mouth, the wine is immediately fruity, supple, soft and rounded with abundant juiciness. The rich, dark berries come through, along with the gentle spice and cocoa notes. The texture is plush and velvety, which makes this a very appealing wine. Good pliable structure and length of flavour.

62 | Argiano, Rosso Di Montalcino | Sangiovese | Italy, Tuscany | £49.50

Deep ruby red in colour. It is medium bodied with a good concentration on the mid-palate. Elegant in the mouth, it is well balanced with tempting flavours of red berries, violets, menthol and earthiness. A generous wine with smooth, velvety tannins that will satisfy all Sangiovese lovers.

Alfredo's favourite

63 | Spencer, Lemberg | Pinotage | South Africa, Tulbagh Valley | £52.00

Dark berry and cherry notes on both the nose and palate are underlined by a mineral core that offers structure and interest. A very drinkable Pinotage. 



Tiago's favourite

Rich and Fuller Bodied Reds

64 | Baglio Gibellina, Passimiento | Nero d'Avola | Italy, Sicily | £29.50

Mediterranean fragrance. Bright intense red, characteristic, intense with hint of red berries fruits. Warm, full-bodied and harmonious in acidity, with smooth and elegant tannins.

65 | Les Oliviers | Carignan, Grenache, Mourvèdre & Syrah | France, Côtes du Rhône | £30.50


Ripe red/dark fruit aromas and that characteristic garrigue and pepper notes. Lovely softness in the mouth with velvety tannins and confit fruits building across the palate, hints of tobacco, leather, and a nice spine of acidity from the Syrah as well as some spicy blackcurrant fruit.  

Jake's favourite


66 | Casas Del Bosque, Reserva | Carmenere | Chile, Rapel Valley | £31.50

Intensely violet in colour, on the nose this wine exhibits notes of cedar, bacon fat, and graphite with just a hint of fresh lavender. In the mouth, an initial attack of black cherry, sweet tobacco and cinnamon gives way to a touch of earthiness and bell pepper. Ripe tannins and fresh acidity give good balance and length.



67 | Zuccardi Valles | Malbec | Argentina, Mendoza | £32.50

This Malbec is a delicious expression of the Uco Valley, with vibrant plum and raspberry flavours complemented with fresh and spicy notes on the finish. 

68 | Paolo Leo Passitivo Organic | Primitivo | Italy, Puglia | £34.00

Intense ruby-red colour, with a complex bouquet, reminiscent of cherries, raspberries and redcurrants. The oak aging adds a pleasant roasted and spicy aroma. On the palate, it is full-bodied, supple and well balanced with a long finish. 

69 | The Ladybird | Cabernet Franc, Cabernet Sauvignon, Malbec, Merlot & Petit Verdot | South Africa, Stellenbosch | £39.50

This wine is a Bordeaux influenced blend, and has a complex nose with hints of spice, chocolate and mocha. Good structure with plum and mineral complexity and a lingering finish. Showing graceful elegance, this wine over delivers on quality and displays this estate as one of the leading lights in South Africa.  

Carmelita's favourite

70 | Grey Glacier | Merlot | Chile, Colchagua Valley | £42.00

Very intense and the oaky overtones and notes of chocolate from the barrel ageing enhance the final complexity of the wine. It is a full-bodied, boldly structured wine, which fills the mouth thanks to its fine tannins. Smooth and persistent in the finish.

71 | Haras De Pirque Hussonet, Gran Reserva | Cabernet Sauvignon, Carmenere & Merlot | Chile, Maipo Valley | £45.00

Mostly Cabernet Sauvignon with a small percentage of Carmenere and Merlot. The nose offers notes of mint and chocolate with typical spicy aromas of laurel, which distinguish the territory, where the grapes are grown. The palate is both concentrated and smooth, with silky and persistent tannins.

72 | Roquette & Cazes | Tinta Barocca & Touriga Nacional | Portugal, Douro | £47.50

The wine shows a deep purple colour. The complex nose, mirroring the palate, reveals fresh berry fruit notes and elegant hints of violet and spice. An elegant start that leads to a well-structured wine, with fine-textured tannins. The finish is fresh and lingering.

73 | Bogle Vineyards | Merlot | USA, California | £49.50

Concentrated and full-bodied, subtle and silky, yet bright and intense, this deep red wine is multifaceted. Black raspberry and dark cherry greet the nose, while the brighter fruit of ripe summer plum dazzles the palate. The toast and spice of twelve months in American oak seamlessly integrate with the tannin structure of this wine, leaving a long, lingering finish.

74 | Domaine Chauveau, Pouilly-Fume, La Charmette | Sauvignon Blanc | France, Loire Valley | £22.50

Clear colour with gold highlights. Citrus fruits and exotic fruits (mango) mainly compose the aromatic profile of this wine. The attack on the palate has a great vivacity, along with chalky mineral notes. Delicate and fresh in the palate with an excellent acidity and structure balance. It contributes to the persistence and pleasantly concludes the tasting.

75 | Terras Gauda, De San Campio | Albarino | Spain, Rias Baixas | £24.50

The nose is filled with white fruit, grapefruit and citrus flavours. No sign of oak and no malolactic fermentation, the wine is therefore as pure and bright as a whistle with mandarin, exotic fruit, pineapple, minerals and sea scents joining in on the palate.

76 | Domaine Colombier, Chablis | Chardonnay | France, Burgundy | £26.50

A lively wine with plenty of acidity and grip, this great Chablis boasts gunflint aromas with minerals dominating the palate.

The palate is all ripe strawberry, citrus and lemongrass. Well balanced with bright acidity and rich enough to pair up with salmon or even duck.

A lovely intense garnet red robe. The nose opens on to small red fruit and blackcurrant. Good attack on the palate with a supple feel and fruit and freshness at the end.

The wine has remarkable body and aromas, with a finesse reminiscent of certain Margaux. A great wine with power, it has richness but also an elegance with fine and tasty tannins. It is pure pleasure with black fruit and an armful of old rose that supports some notes of exotic wood.

80 | Segla 2nd Wine of Ch. Rauzan-Segla, Margaux | Cab Sauvignon & Merlot | France, Bordeaux | £47.50

Elegant, refined texture, the depth, the length and breadth of flavour. The nose is ripe and fragrant, with notes of blackcurrant, damson, violet and toasted oak. The tannins are soft and silky, with a persistent finish.
