Hint of salinity on the nose carries through to the palate and complements a barrage of stone fruit flavours which lead on to a minerally citrus finish. Lightly oak touched which gives more of a rounded mouthfeel. 🕢

### 80 | Evaristo Tinto | Alicante, Cabernet Sauvignon, Shiraz & Touriga Nacional | Lisboa | £26.00

A deliciously fruity blend of indigenous Portuguese and international grape varieties grown in the vineyards surrounding Lisbon. This easy-drinking wine is bursting with aromas of ripe cherries, juicy blackberries and blackcurrants. (

### 81 | Invincible, DOC Numero Dois | Tinta Roriz & Touriga Nacional | Douro | £57.50

Lovely ripe fruit flavours and complex spicy layers - the complexity coming from the old vines. This wine has seen oak but Lightly oak touched which gives more of a rounded mouthfeel and the tannins are very soft and smooth.

### 40 | Burgo Viejo, Blanco | Viura | Rioja | £29.50

Straw yellow colour, bright and clear. Aromas of green apple, hay and peach. Fresh and buttery, extremely balanced in the mouth.

### 41 | Bodegaverde San Valero | Macabeo | Aragon | £34.50

An impressive example of Spain's iconic white varieties, from the sea-swept Rías Baixas region. The juicy fruit is lifted by delicious freshness, with notes of stone fruit and minerality. A treat for lovers of elegantly aromatic whites.

### 42 | Mar de Frades | Albariño | Rias Baixas | £47.00

Pale lemon colour and lime green reflections. Aromas of orange peel and lychee interspersed with white flowers and mineral notes. Balsamic nuances mark its freshness and salinity. On the palate, it is powerful and balanced with an elegant, delicate finish.

### 82 | Gran Cerdo | Tempranillo | Rioja | £29.00

This brilliant colour Gran Cerdo reveals primary notes of strawberry, raspberry and cherry. Clean mineral tones. The herbaceous flavours give the wine a slight green finish with a little spice, while the tannin and acidity cry out for some red meat. 🕝 🎧

#### 83 | Vina Zorzal, Joven | Garnacha | Navarra | £42.00

On the nose, clove, black fruit, followed by soft cherry and ripe fruit aromas. The palate is very soft, full-bodied and powerful, with a long, balanced aftertaste. Ideal for cured ham, stew and meat dishes.

### 84 | Picaro del Aguila | Bobal, Garnacha & Tempranillo | Ribera del Duero | £68.00

Aromas of blackberry, blueberry and dark cherry, coupled with vanilla, sweet spice and chalky tannin. A fresher style of Ribera del Duero that aims for elegance over extraction.

### 43 | The Liberator - This is the Sea | Albariño | Coastal Region | £34.50

Zesty and energetic, with notes of pithy lemon and loads of floral lift, too. There's a salty tang on the finish that would make it the perfect foil for seafood.

### 44 | Catherine Marshall, Jono's Wave, Amatra | Chenin Blanc | Stellenbosch | £42

Bright, fresh, sweet melon and white peach top notes with fleshy ripe nectarines on the core and crisp green apple acidity on the finish. A rich mid-palate of lanolin adds depth and complexity to the wet granite stone texture.

### 45 | Jordan, Nine Yards | Chardonnay | Stellenbosch | £67

The Ultimate Expression of Jordan Terroir. A rich, modern, yet classically defined style with full flavours of clove flower, butterscotch and lime oil. A statement wine which goes the 'whole nine yeards'.

### 85 | 'Protea', Anthonij Rupert Wyne | Merlot | Franschhoek | £36

Bright black and blueberry aromas and cocoa nuances. The mouth is packed with the same ripe and juicy black fruits with a deeper note of rich, dark chocolate and spicy fruitcake. The texture is plush and velvety, which makes this a very appealing wine. Good pliable structure and length of flavour.

### 86 | Kanonkop Kadette | Pinotage | Stellenbosch | £42

Intense purple hues with lively aromas of fresh plums, mulberries and allspice, followed by a meaty undertone. The palate displays an inherent earthy touch, with flavours of crimson beetroot and maraschino cherries. Coherent balance between the fruit and the fresh acidity.

### 87 | Catherine Marshall, On Clay Soils | Pinot Noir | Elgin | £49.50

A broad, seductive compote of concentrated black cherries, cranberries displaying layered, textured truffle savouriness and earthy forest floor interwoven with concentrated black cherry compote harmoniously supported by mineral tannin.

### 46 | Corryton Burge | Chardonnay | South Australia | £31.00

A lively, rich, round and creamy South Australian Chardonnay. Pale to yellow straw, Aromatic white nectarine, with hints of peach and pear. Palate provides generous fresh stone fruit and honeydew melon with a hint of creamy shortbread richness all brought together with moderate acidity to provide balance.

### 47 | Philip Shaw, The Dreamer | Viognier | New South Wales | £45.50

The Dreamer is light straw yellow in colour with hues of green. Fresh apricots and violets on the nose with lifts of lemon. The palate is bright and fresh with vivid acid and juicy fruit. The balance of fruit and acid give the wine depth and vibrancy.

### 48 | Pewsey Vale | Riesling | Eden Valley | £47.50

Intense fruit aromas of talcum and lemon lime fruit, with a hint of fresh pineapple overlaying dried herbs. The palate shows great length and depth with limes, a hint of pineapple, white flowers and fresh rosemary.

### 88 | Corryton Burge | Shiraz | South Australia | £31

Deep ruby red with purple hues, strawberry, raspberry and vanilla aromas. Rich fruit forward characters of raspberry and plums tantalise the palate. There is a soft toasty oak influence that enhances the vanilla and spice. Subtle tannins leave the palate quite moreish and a delight to keep coming back to.

#### 89 | Vasse Felix Filius | Cabernet Sauvignon | Margaret River | £47.00

Juicy, intense, and luscious on entry with fast building super fine and powdery tannin. It is soft yet solid, elegantly taut, and superluscious with concentrated fresh raspberry, vanilla pod and savoury nutmeg on the finish.

### 90 | Kooyong Massale | Pinot Noir | Mornington Peninsula | £62

The nose is vibrantly fruited, with dark cherry and raspberry aromas, floral elements and top notes of savoury spice, earth and undergrowth. The palate is generous, with attractive yet balanced ripeness propelling the red fruits and spicy dark floral characters. Balanced acidity and fine tannins help this wine to linger.

### 50 | Wildsong Organic | Pinot Gris | Hawkes Bay | £39.50

Pear, lychee and quince, muddled with loquat, almond and nectarine. An attractive textured palate with a balanced, dry finish that suits drinking chilled on its own or served alongside pretty much anything.

### 51 | Little Beauty | Gewurztraminer | Marlborough | £52.00

Exotic and intriguing. Middle-eastern spices such as star anise, clove & cinnamon. Lychee and rose petals. On the palate the characters are intriguing and plentiful, nougat, orange and rose oil. Finishes with a rich and satisfying roundness.

### 91 | Trinity Hill | Syrah | Hawkes Bay | £49.50

Combines spice and pepper with ripe blackberry fruit for a rich and soft palate offering a long and complex finish.

### 92 | Tohu | Pinot Noir | Marlborough | £52.00

A bright ruby hue in the glass, this Awatere Valley Pinot Noir displays aromatic layers of red fruit and spicy florals with hints of crushed herbs. The palate is smooth with flavours of bright cherry, red berries and finely integrated French oak. Mid-weight on the palate, this wine is balanced with refined silky tannins that lead to a long and elegant finish.

### 93 | Seifried Aotea | Cabernet Franc | Nelson | £58.00
