Bottle £36 | 125ml £7.20 | 175ml £9.45 | 250ml £13.45

On the nose citrus fruits and herbaceous characters. Luscious flavours of lemon zest and guava with notes of fresh bell pepper. Finely balanced with a hint of residual sweetness.

31 | Pasarisa | Torrontes | Argentina, Salta  
Bottle £35 | 125ml £7 | 175ml £9.15 | 250ml £13.10

A refined, high altitude white from Salta. Fresh and light with floral notes of rose petal, citrus zest and subtle spicy undertone.

45 | The Wolfrap White | Chenin Blanc | South Africa, Western Cape  
Bottle £36 | 125ml £7.20 | 175ml £9.45 | 250ml £13.45

Bright and aromatic, with flavours of peach, lemon zest, nectarine, and a touch of spice. Balanced acidity and a smooth, clean finish.

Seduces with aromatic intensity of violets and cherries. Lively, light and refreshing.

Bottle £32 | 125ml £6.40 | 175ml £8.40 | 250ml £11.95

This delicate and refreshing Sauvignon Blanc displays a vibrant natural aromatic character with crisp and a refined mineral finish.

## Rosé

14 | Seymour Rosé | Languedoc-Roussillon, France |  
Bottle £32 | 125ml £6.40 | 175ml £8.40 | 250ml £11.95

A beautifully delicate, pale pink rosé. Soft and fruity with hints of rose petal and wild strawberry followed by a dry, well-balanced palate of supple summer fruits.

## Red

### 3 | Villa Sandi Il Fresco Prosecco DOC Treviso Brut | Glera | Italy, Veneto | £38

Very pale straw yellow and fine, persistent perlage. The aroma is fruity and flowery with hints of ripe golden apple and small mountain flowers. The dry, fresh and flavoursome sensation on the palate followed by a fruity and harmonious aftertaste.

### 4 | Villa Sandi Il Fresco Prosecco DOC Rosé Millesimato Brut | Glera & Pinot Nero | Italy, Veneto | £40

An elegant pink colour with coppery reflections. Its aromatic freshness offers a bouquet of red fruits and floral scents among which notes of pomegranate and rose stand out. On the palate it is silky and full, with a pleasant balance.

### 5 | Bodegas Sumarroca, Cava Brut Reserva | Blend | Spain, Cava | £49.50

Rich, full complex and toasty. Pale yellow colour. Fresh aroma and fruity and fresh on the palate with fine, pleasant bubbles that perfectly complement the wine's structure.

### 6 | Terres Secretes Cremant de Bourgogne Blanc de Blanc | Chardonnay | France, Burgundy | £45

A neat and fresh palate. Delicate and floral aromas shine through on the palate in this Blanc de Blancs, thanks to full flavours from white flowers, peach, pear and honeysuckle.

## Champagne

### 7 | Ayala Brut 'Majeur' NV | Chardonnay, Pinot Meunier and Pinot Noir | France, Champagne | £78

Crisp and lively, displaying a harmonious balance of bright acidity and rich fruit flavours. Flavours of lemon, white peach, and a touch of mineral complexity unfold, leading to a clean and elegant finish that lingers beautifully.

### 8 | Ayala Brut 'Majeur' NV | 37.5cl | Chardonnay, Pinot Meunier and Pinot Noir | France, Champagne | £46

### 9 | Ayala Rosé 'Majeur' NV | Chardonnay, Pinot Meunier and Pinot Noir | France, Champagne | £89

Vibrant flavours of red gooseberries and raspberries, leading to a lengthy and voluptuous finish that lingers delightfully. Its smooth texture and balanced acidity make it incredibly versatile.

### 10 | Billecart-Salmon Brut Reserve NV | Chardonnay, Pinot Meunier & Pinot Noir | France, Champagne | £125

Without doubt, one of the finest, yet least known Grande Marque Champagnes, made with mainly Chardonnay and Pinot Meunier. This Champagne is lively, elegantly textured and fresh with a very long finish.

### 11 | Billecart-Salmon Brut Rosé NV | Chardonnay & Pinot Noir | France, Champagne | £165

Such an elegant, ethereal wine, this orange-pink wine is dry and crisp with fruity raspberry flavour at the fore.

### 12 | Bollinger Brut Special Cuvee NV | Chardonnay, Pinot Meunier & Pinot Noir | France, Champagne | £145

A traditional Champagne, with a yeasty nose, crisp acidity and a rich, full-bodied palate. A golden colour, distinctive of black grape varieties, very fine bubbles. It has a beautiful aromatic complexity of ripe fruit and spices, with hints of roasted apples and peaches. A subtle combination of structure, length and vivacity; present pear, brioche and notes of fresh walnut on the palate.

## Delicate & Uplifting

### 20 | Little Beauty | Pinot Gris | New Zealand, Marlborough | £42

Fresh and vibrant, bursting with delicate aromas of ripe pear, melon, and citrus zest. Its crisp acidity and subtle floral notes create a lively, balanced palate, with a light touch of spice and a clean, mineral finish.

### 21 | El Camaron 'Val do Salnes' | Albariño | Spain, Rias Baixas and Galacia | £41

Citrus, minerality and saline notes throughout. The palate is light and fresh yet offers underlying depth and texture.

### 22 | Xavier Roger 'Coquille de Mer' | Vermentino | South of France | £32

An exotic and lighter-style dry white, this zingy, zesty white offers a bright and refreshing profile. Great alternative to Sauvignon Blanc.

### 23 | Clos Des Orfeuilles Muscadet Sur Lie | Melon de Bourgogne | France, Loire Valley | £36

A crisp, light-bodied white with citrus, green apple, and mineral notes. Fresh, dry, with a delicate texture, and lively acidity.

### 24 | Ormarine 'Plo de l'Isabelle' | Picpoul de Pinet | France, Languedoc | £34

A snappy nose of lemon and lime fruit, with vibrant green apple. A racy wine with a lip-tingling finish,

### 25 | Nicolas Bergaglio Gavi di Gavi La Minaia | Cortese | Italy, Gavi di Gavi | £42

Zesty citrus, crisp green apple, and a touch of white peach with a whisper of almond and wild herbs. Dry, clean, and elegant with a mineral backbone and a bright, mouth-watering finish.

### 26 | Pierre Brevin Pouilly-Fumé | Sauvignon Blanc | France, Loire | £52

Subtle aromas of grass, fennel and gunflint. A ripe grapefruit palate with refreshing, zesty acidity.

### 27 | Catherine Marshall | Riesling | South Africa, Elgin | £42

Exudes sweet yet persistent fresh limes, crisp apple, beeswax and wild honey. The fresh acidity is well balanced with the fruit sweetness and supported by mineral texture from the shale soils and a long, intense, sherbet finish.

Secondary characteristics underlying limes and flowers include a tinge of lamp oil.

### 28 | Kono | Sauvignon Blanc | New Zealand, Marlborough | £36

On the nose citrus fruits and herbaceous characters. Luscious flavours of lemon zest and guava with notes of fresh bell pepper. Finely balanced with a hint of residual sweetness.

### 29 | Chin Chin | Arinto & Loureiro | Portugal, Vinho Verde | £36

Crisp, refreshing white with aromas of green apple, citrus zest, and a touch of fresh herbs. Flavours of lemon, lime, and a hint of melon unfold, complemented by a slight effervescence that adds a fun, spritz quality.

## Balanced & Satisfying

### 30 | Little Beauty 'Black Edition – Wild Ferment' | Sauvignon Blanc | New Zealand, Marlborough | £46

Exotic, intriguing, integrated, opulent and thought provoking. Wild flowers, wild herbs, grilled apricot, frozen mango, dried dates, nutty, crème brûlée, passion-fruit pulp, brioche, baking bread, sandalwood...it goes on and on!

### 31 | Pazarisa | Torrontes | Argentina, Salta | £35

A refined, high altitude white from Salta. Fresh and light with floral notes of rose petal, citrus zest and subtle spicy undertone.

### 32 | Henri Ehrhart 'Element Terre' | Riesling | France, Alsace | £36

Aromatic nose, citrus notes and minerality. Lively and powerful with a beautiful long finish,

### 33 | Domaine Wachau 'Federspiel' | Grüner Veltliner | Austria, Wachau | £38

Pear, spicy notes and white pepper. Multi-layered with juicy fruit and a salty, smoky finish.

### 34 | Cometa Planeta | Fiano | Italy, Sicily | £76

Complex and intense. Aromas of chamomile, thyme and mango. Flavours of apricot, almond and basil.

### 35 | Marabino Muscatedda | Moscato di Noto | Italy, Sicily | £62

Aromatic grape variety used for the production of natural sweet wines, straw wines and fortified wines, here interpreted in a dry version. Bright, aromatic, with white peach, orange blossom and wild herb notes. Dry with a generous, saline finish.

### 36 | Domaine Passy Le Clou Chablis | Chardonnay | France, Burgundy | £49

Golden colour with an expressive nose of floral notes and green apple. Classic Chablis minerality.

### 37 | Domaine Reverdy Ducroux Sancerre | Sauvignon Blanc | France, Loire Valley | £55

Light yellow colour, floral and fruity notes. Well balanced on the palate with good freshness.

### 38 | Jacques Bavard Bourgogne Blanc | Chardonnay | France, Burgundy | £72

White flower aromas like acacia, lily-of-the-valley and lime blossom open the nose, followed by toasted-oak and buttery notes. On the palate, the attack is crisp and bright, finishing with a subtle saline bitterness that gives structure.

### 39 | Rafael Cambra Soplo Blanco | Malvasia Bianca & Viura | Spain, Valencia | £39.50

Bright, fresh, sweet melon and white peach top notes with fleshy ripe nectarines on the core and crisp green apple acidity on the finish. A rich mid-palate of lanolin adds depth and complexity to the wet granite stone texture.

## Opulent & Distinguished

**40 | Bruce Jack, Ghost in the Machine Clairette Blanche | Clairette | South Africa, Western Cape | £35**  
Vanilla, caramel and toffee with white nectarine and almond. Zesty finish with lemon grass.

**41 | Josh Cellars Reserve North Coast | Chardonnay | USA, California | £49**  
On the nose bright citrus, lemon curd and peach. Lemon zest, peaches and vanilla on the palate.

**42 | Catena Zapata, Catena Alta | Chardonnay | Argentina, Mendoza | £69**  
Rich, high altitude Chardonnay. Concentrated layers of poached pear, apricot and white flowers. Buttery mouthfeel with elegant toasted oak.

**43 | Domaine Du Chardonnay Chablis 1er Cru 'Montmains' | Chardonnay | France, Burgundy | £72**  
Crisp, slate-like bouquet that is very well defined and focused. The palate is well balanced with an attractive oyster shell note on the entry, the acidity well judged with the price of the fresh, lime and apple tinged finish.

**44 | Joseph Drouhin Pouilly-Fuisse | Chardonnay | France, Burgundy | £96**  
Lush and attractive. Perfumed with almonds and ripe orchard fruits, refreshed by a lemon spritz and a rounded, creamy texture.

**45 | The Wolftrap White | Chenin Blanc | South Africa, Western Cape | £36**  
Bright and aromatic, with flavours of peach, lemon zest, nectarine, and a touch of spice. Balanced acidity and a smooth, clean finish.

**46 | Domaine Alain Chavy, Puligny-Montrachet 'Les 8 Climats' | Chardonnay | France, Burgundy | £155**  
Exotic Puligny-Montrachet bursting with pineapple and guava. Balanced with precise lime acidity and sophisticated spicy oak.

**47 | Vignerons Ardechois, Terre Eglantier | Viognier | France, Ardeche | £40**  
Aromatic notes of white flowers, apricot, and peach, complemented by hints of pastry. The palate is fresh and generous with a minty finish.

**48 | Jean-Charles Fagot, Bourgogne Aligote, Vieilles Vigne | France, Burgundy | £56**  
Bright acidity drives a linear core of citrus pith, Granny Smith apple and tart pear, balanced by a mineral saline thread that frames the fruit without overwhelming it. Mid palate, richness hints at lees contact: soft bodied, creamy accents emerge, knitting with the wine's taut structure to produce an impression of weight without heaviness. Flavours of verbena, green tea and a touch of dried herbs unfold, adding complexity and depth.

**49 | Mabis Biscardo, Lugana 'Morena Bianca' | Chardonnay & Lugana | France, Burgundy | £72**  
A beautifully poised, fresh mineral white. A floral almond nose with juicy pear and melon fruits on the palate.

## Refined Rosé

### 80 | Biscardo Rosapasso | Pinot Noir | Italy, Veneto | £38

A brilliant rose colour, the bouquet of elegant wild strawberry and cherry lead onto the smooth and harmonic palate. Excellent with fish, cheese and lightly flavoured risottos and pasta.

### 81 | Chateau M de Minuty | Grenache & Cinsault | France, Côtes de Provence | £48

Aromas of fresh strawberries, watermelon, and citrus, drawing in the senses with its vibrant fruit profile. The palate is bright and crisp, offering refreshing acidity that enhances its lightness. Subtle mineral notes provide an added depth.

### 82 | Beronia Rioja | Tempranillo | Spain, Rioja | £35

Pink quartz colour. Elegant and aromatic with distinct notes of cherry and rose petal.

### 83 | Hubert Sancerre | Pinot Noir | France, Loire Valley | £56

Burst of fresh, crisp elegance. Delightful aromas of strawberry, raspberry, and a hint of citrus mingle with subtle mineral undertones. On the palate, it's beautifully bright, with lively acidity and a clean, refreshing finish.

### 84 | Henri Ehrhart, Ehrh'Art | Pinot Noir | France, Alsace | £37

Seduces with aromatic intensity of violets and cherries. Lively, light and refreshing.



## Elegant & Poised

### 50 | Little Beauty | Pinot Noir | New Zealand, Marlborough | £76

Fresh and vibrant, bursting with ripe cherry, raspberry, and strawberry notes. It is silky, smooth, with delicate tannins, and lively acidity. Subtle spice and earth undertones add complexity.

### 51 | Domaine du Sabot Beaujolais Villages | Gamay | France, Beaujolais | £36

Packed with juicy strawberry, raspberry and cherry fruit flavours. Bright and youthful.

### 52 | Henri Ehrhart, Chêne 18 Mois | Pinot Noir | France, Alsace | £38

Aging in oak gives it melted tannins and persistence. Rich with aromas of red fruits.

### 53 | La Cueva, Inacayal | Carignan & Pais | Chile, Colchagua Valley | £35

Organically grown without any irrigation, as the vines thrive in the natural, dry heat of the Colchagua Valley. The result is a moreish red packed with black and red berry fruit, pepper spice and a delicate note of violet on the finish.

### 54 | Envinata, Lousas, Vino de Aldea | Mencía | Spain, Galicia | £90

Fresh and juicy, with notes of red cherry, violet, and wild herbs. Light-bodied with smooth tannins and a mineral finish.

### 55 | Gorgo di Roberta, Bricolo Bardolino | Corvina, Rondinella | Italy, Veneto | £39.50

Lively and approachable red, bursting with ripe cherry, raspberry, and plum flavours. It's bright, juicy, and perfect for casual drinking or pairing with grilled meats, pasta, or cheese. With soft tannins and a fresh finish.

### 56 | Finca Manzanos | Tempranillo | Spain, Rioja | £32

A vibrant nose of red cherry, plum, and raspberry, with hints of vanilla and a touch of spice. On the palate, it is medium-bodied, with smooth tannins and balanced acidity. Flavours of ripe red fruit, blackberry, and a subtle oak influence unfold, leading to a soft, lingering finish.

### 57 | Rafael Cambra Soplo | Forcallà, Garnacha & Monastrell | Spain, Valencia | £42

A brilliant rose colour, the bouquet of elegant wild strawberry and cherry lead onto the smooth and harmonic palate. Excellent with fish, cheese and lightly flavoured risottos and pasta.

### 58 | Cantina di Negrar, Valpolicella Classico | Corvina, Corvinone, Rondinella | Italy, Veneto | £35

A dry, medium-bodied red with aromas of red fruits, vinous and spicy notes. The palate is warm and velvety, featuring balanced tannins and a harmonious structure.

### 59 | Naciente Morande | Pinot Noir | Chile, Casablanca Valley | £32

Violet-red with fresh red fruits, light spice, herbs, and earthy notes. Delicate, fresh palate with balanced acidity and fine tannins, finishing with red berries and hints of dark chocolate and coffee.

## Structured & Satisfying

**60 | Clairmont, Les Palais, Crozes-Hermitage | Syrah | France, Rhône Valley | £45**  
Bright purple. Nose of red fruits. Palate asserts itself with delicate, gastronomic tannins.

**61 | M. Chapoutier, Côtes du Rhône Rouge | Grenache & Syrah | France, Côtes du Rhône | £38**  
Deep ruby colour and an inviting bouquet of ripe red fruits, including cherry and raspberry, complemented by notes of blackcurrant and subtle spice. On the palate, it is medium-bodied with a smooth, easy-drinking character, where soft tannins and lively acidity balance fruit-forward flavours. A touch of peppery spice and earthiness enhances the experience, leading to a satisfying finish.

**62 | Chateau la Bastidette Montagne St Emilion | Merlot | France, Bordeaux | £59.50**  
Juicy black cherry and plum with notes of violet, cedar and graphite. Medium-bodied with smooth tannins, soft spice and a fresh, rounded finish typical of Right Bank Merlot.

**63 | Domaine La Ligière Vacqueyras | Grenache, Mourvedre & Syrah | France, Southern Rhône | £62.50**  
rich and full-bodied, offering deep flavours of black cherry, plum, and blackberry, layered with notes of garrigue herbs, pepper, and a hint of liquorice. The tannins are firm yet polished, balanced by vibrant acidity and a long, savoury finish.

**64 | The Stump Jump, D'Arenberg GSM | Grenache, Shiraz & Mourvedre | Australia, McLaren Vale | £32**  
Ruby red with bright aromas of red berries and spice. Vibrant, easy drinking and approachable.

**65 | Beronia, Rioja Edición Limitada | Tempranillo | Spain, Rioja | £35**  
Red cherry, cinnamon and cacao. Velvety tannins balanced with dark fruit for a silky finish.

**66 | Da Vinci Chianti Reserva | Sangiovese | Italy, Tuscany | £36.50**  
A charming Chianti full of fruit and spice, juicy and approachable, with cherries offset by an exotic perfume of vanilla and cinnamon.

**67 | Michel Lynch | Merlot | France, Bordeaux | £36**  
Rich ruby with blackcurrant, black cherry and violet, leading to a supple, round palate and a smooth, fruity finish.

**68 | Bruce Jack, Ghost in the Machine | Malbec & Viognier | South Africa, Western Cape | £38**  
Herbaceous with hints of fynbos and tobacco leaf. Palate bursts with plum and cherries.

**69 | L'Etoile de Villegeorge Haut-Médoc | Cabernet Sauvignon & Merlot | France, Bordeaux | £36.50**  
Fragrant Bordeaux. Strawberries and raspberries with a bouquet of peonies and pepper.

## Robust & Grand

### 70 | Marabino Rosso di Contrada | Nero d'Avola | Italy, Sicily | £62.50

Juicy Nero d'Avola with ripe cherry, black berry and plum, touched by spice and earthy clay. The tannins are gentle, the texture smooth, and there's bright freshness and minerality from the soil.

### 71 | Chateauneuf-du-Pape 'Closierie de Vaudieu' | Grenache, Syrah & Mourvèdre | France, Rhône | £74

Deep ruby red in the glass. La Closierie de Vaudieu has a complex nose, with notes of ripe red cherry and blackberry alongside subtle aromas of dried herbs and liquorice. On the palate, it is full-bodied with ripe, soft tannins that gently carry the cherry, cassis and dried herb flavours on the finish.

### 72 | Kanonkop Kadette | Pinotage | South Africa, Stellenbosch | £48

Intense purple hues with lively aromas of fresh plums, mulberries and allspice, followed by a meaty undertone. The palate displays an inherent earthy touch, with flavours of crimson beetroot and maraschino cherries. Coherent balance between the fruit and the fresh acidity.

### 73 | Paolo Leo Passitivo Organic | Primitivo | Italy, Puglia | £38

Intense ruby-red colour, with a complex bouquet, reminiscent of cherries, raspberries and redcurrants. The oak aging adds a pleasant roasted, spicy aroma. On the palate, it is full-bodied, supple and well balanced with a long finish.

### 74 | Bruce Jack, Ghost in the Machine | Cabernet Franc | South Africa, Western Cape | £35

Burst of dark red fruits and blackberry. Palate follows through with a spicy and smoky finish.

### 75 | Schroeder, Saurus Select | Malbec | Argentina, Patagonia | £48

Deep purple-red with ripe currants, plums, and sour cherry on the nose, plus spicy notes like white pepper, vanilla, coffee, and dark chocolate. Smooth, velvety tannins and a lingering, structured finish.

### 76 | Josh Cellars, Reserve, North Coast | Cabernet Sauvignon | USA, Californian | £49

Caramel, strawberry and black pepper with a long and smooth finish.

### 77 | Meerlust, Rubicon | Cabernet Sauvignon | South Africa, Stellenbosch | £105

A South African classic with notes of black fruit, cedar, tobacco leaf and spice.

### 78 | Chateau Batailley, Lions de Batailley, Pauillac | Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc & Merlot France, Bordeaux | £89

Intense flavour, great structure and ripe tannins. Fresh and earthy with tobacco and raspberries.

### 79 | Estezargues, Les Oliviers | Carignan, Grenache, Mourvèdre & Syrah | France, Côtes du Rhône | £35

Juicy blackberries, ripe plum, and a touch of black pepper, balanced with soft tannins and a hint of garrigue herbs. Smooth, ripe, and easy going.

## Smaller Pours (37.5cl)

### White

**85 | Domaine Chauveau, Pouilly-Fume, La Charmette | Sauvignon Blanc | France, Loire Valley | £29.50**

Clear colour with gold highlights. Citrus fruits and exotic fruits (mango) mainly compose the aromatic profile of this wine. The attack on the palate has a great vivacity, along with chalky mineral notes. Delicate and fresh.

**86 | Domaine Fourrey, Chablis | Chardonnay | Burgundy | £32**

Bright and fresh, with green apple, citrus zest and subtle white flowers. Light to medium-bodied, with a clean, mineral chalky/oyster-shell finish and a touch of lees texture.

### Rosé

**87 | Chateau M de Minuty | Grenache & Cinsault | France, Côtes de Provence | £28**

Aromas of fresh strawberries, watermelon, and citrus, drawing in the senses with its vibrant fruit profile. The palate is bright and crisp, offering refreshing acidity that enhances its lightness. Subtle mineral notes provide an added depth.

### Red

**88 | Chateau Argadens, Superior Rouge | Merlot & Cabernet Sauvignon | France, Bordeaux | £26.50**

This vintage offers a dark and bright colour. The nose, although young, is remarkably rich. It reveals great aromatic complexity with notes of fresh fruit, red and blackberries accompanied by toasted notes. On the palate, it is structured and elegant and beautifully balanced which gives it a great persistent finish.

**89 | Segla 2<sup>nd</sup> Wine of Ch. Rauzan-Segla, Margaux | Cab Sauvignon & Merlot | France, Bordeaux | £55**

Elegant, refined texture, the depth, the length and breadth of flavour. The nose is ripe and fragrant, with notes of blackcurrant, damson, violet and toasted oak. The tannins are soft and silky, with a persistent finish.

**100 | Thomson & Scott, Naughty Organic Sparkling | Chardonnay | Germany | £32**  
Elegant pale colour with a crisp and ripe apple scent accompanied by a touch of sweetness.

**101 | Thomson & Scott, Naughty Organic Sparkling Rosé | Tempranillo | Germany | £34**  
Beautiful classic rosé in colour with a scent of freshly picked berries. The balance between sweetness and acidity is in perfect harmony.

## White

**102 | Darling Cellars, De-alcoholised Wine, 0.5ABV | Sauvignon Blanc | South Africa | £26**  
The De-alcoholised white made of 100% Sauvignon Blanc is a light yellow with green tint in colour, flavours of ripe tropical fruit, yellow peaches and gooseberries complimented by a fresh acidity and lingering finish.

## Rosé

**103 | Darling Cellars Rosé, De-alcoholised Wine, 0.5ABV | Grenache & Sauvignon Blanc | South Africa | £26**  
A blend of Sauvignon Blanc and Grenache, this Rosé has a great light salmon pink colour, with ripe strawberries and sweet candyfloss on the nose following through to a balanced palate with a lingering finish.

## Red

**104 | Darling Cellars, De-alcoholised Wine, 0.5ABV | Syrah | South Africa | £26**  
Made of 100% Shiraz is deep ruby red in colour with hints of ripe red fruit, crushed black pepper, dried rose petals, candied cherries and well-integrated French Oak tannins.

## After Dinner Treats

**90 | Chambers, Rosewood Vineyard | Muscat | Rutherglen Victoria, Australia | £46 | 75ml £11.05**

The Rutherglen Muscat is typically tawny red in colour with aromas of rose petals, raisins and dried fruit. These characters carry through to the palate, balanced with fresh acidity. The wine is unctuous and rich yet zesty and balanced.

**91 | Le Trianon de Filhot | Sauternes | France, Bordeaux | £38 | 75ml £9.15**

Trianon has a brilliant gold robe with golden reflections. The nose reveals notes of dried apricots, lemon and honey. On the palate, the Trianon has a nice balance on freshness supported by a supple structure.

**92 | Lustau, San Emilio | Pedro Ximenez | Spain, Jerez | £80 | 75ml £9.60**

Super-concentrated flavours of raisins and figs. Ebony coloured and lusciously sweet. Velvety and soft on the palate it retains a perfect balance and long finish.

**93 | Royal Tokaji, Blue Label, 5 Puttonyos | Furmint, Hárslevelû & Muscat | Hungary, Tokaj | £110 | 75ml £14.40**

Irresistible dessert wine with apricot, honey, orange marmalade and sweet spice notes.

**94 | Domaine De Durban, Muscat de Beaumes de Venise | Muscat | France, Rhône | £42 | 75ml £10.10**

Aromatic complexity and elegance, often presenting rich notes of fresh fruits, floral accents, and a lively, refreshing finish.

**95 | Charles Hours, Jurancon Moelleux, Uroulat | Petit Manseng | South of France | £45 | 75ml £10.80**

Fresh and expressive, featuring notes of honey, ripe apricot, candied fruit, pineapple, and citrus hints. Rich and generous without being cloying, offering a fine balance between high residual sugar and fresh acidity.

## Velvety & Rich

**96 | Quinta De La Rosa Ruby Reserve | Portugal | £48 | 50ml £5.80**

Smooth and ripe with jammy black brambles, great depth and smooth tannins, and like all La Rosa Ports, it is not too sweet. Fresh and light-hearted. It is natural with salted nuts or dark chocolate and does not require decanting.

**97 | Sandeman, Tawny, 10 Year Old | Portugal | £69.50 | 50ml £5.60**

Pale in colour and light in body, the nose opens with aromas of vanilla and raisins. On the palate, there is a great balance between fresh fruit flavours and more complex, spicy flavours from oak ageing. The finish is fresh and long lasting.

**98 | Quinta De La Rosa LBV | Portugal | £58 | 50ml £7**

Rich, velvety Port packed with ripe blackcurrant, plum, and cherry flavours. Notes of spice, cocoa, and a hint of floral add depth and complexity. Smooth tannins and fresh acidity create a balanced, approachable profile.

**99 | Quinta De La Rosa, Colheita 2012 | Portugal | £99 | 50ml £11.90**

Incredibly distinctive. It balances dense and rich fruit, with the seductive notes aged tawny notes.
